## Admission Criteria

To be considered for admission into the program, students must meet the following criteria:

Complete university admission requiremetots include submission of official transcripts from all colleges/unrersities attended.

Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 for all college work (including transfer work and exalting developmental courses) and be in good cademic standing.

Score a minimum of 60% on the ATI TEAS exam.

LPNs must provide proof of an active, unencumbered LPN license to practice in Arkansas to be eligible for the LPN-ADN track.
